The legendary Renault R4 that appears in the 1967-74 model version has a much more down-to-earth feel. It will be joined by the Borgward flatbed truck with newly designed front sec-

tion as customer service vehicle and the NSU Fiat Jagst in its closed saloon version. Fans of classic trucks will find much model-making fun this time with the Büssing BS 16 stanchion trailer truck – for the first time, with the new "Trilex" rims – and the BP airport tanker on the chassis of the International Harvester. Besides that, the MAN "Pausbacke" completes an impressive chemical trailer truck for the first time – a contemporary combination par

excellence has emerged. WIKING also miniaturises the John Deere 7280R with moving front loader, the VW Amarok as well as the multi-purpose boat of Lehmar, painted in the colours of the THW – all based on bang up-to-date prototypes.
