

NEW MODELS FOR AUGUST 2011 AIRY GOGGOMOBIL



Both are classics which are inextricably linked with the post-war history of Germany: WIKING's new models for August include the Glas Goggomobil with folding roof in filigree detail and the Ford FK 1000 as a box van. Thanks to the typical craftsmanship of WIKING, both of these new models display intricate detail and high-quality finishing. Other newcomers to the summer range include the Ford Granada as a police vehicle and the Magirus 235 D as

a "Transthermos" articulated truck with refrigerated trailer, bringing their own youngtimer flair. A poured asphalt mixer truck-trailer combination arrives to liven things up on the construction site while the Puch all-terrain vehicle in the livery of the mountain rescue service and the VW T1 twin cab police vehicle are already on the move. These are joined by an addition to the successful series of die-cast models of the latest agricultural machines on a scale of 1:32 in the form of the John

Deere 7430 which is fitted with a fully functioning front loader just waiting to be used. Fans of this scale will be delighted with the model constructed using a combination of zinc die-cast components and plastic parts which demonstrates both the highest possible level of detailing and a perfect quality finish.
