IKING has guaranteed a summer of fun for model enthusiasts: the VW Passat B7 Variant as an emergency doctor's car is the latest addition to the range of emergency vehicles along with the VW Amarok with hard top and rollbar and the DRK car trailer. The new models for August also include agricultural models on contrasting scales à la WIKING: the John Deere 990 baler with working fast release system and

textile curtain makes an appearance in the form of a precision model in 1:32 along with the intricately detailed Fendt 939 Vario in 1:87. Classic vehicle enthusiasts will also enjoy the Gasolin tank truck trailer with its Mercedes-Benz Pullman truck, the NSU Fiat Jagst with sunroof along with the Ford Granada as a fire service emergency control vehicle and the Ford Escort "Super". WIKING has kitted out the legendary Hanomag L28 with an open

drinks container body typical of the 1950s and evokes memories of its own made-up brand of lemonade "WIMO Sip". In addition, WIKING has used historic moulds to create a new model of the Opel Blitz flatbed truck trailer carrying a cargo of street lamps.

ang up-to-date and definitely understated: the latest generation Beetle does credit to the retro Beetle - an impressive appearance for the likeable VW. One model making a reappearance is the Opel Kapitän  $5\overline{1}$ which paved the way for WIKING's offensive of classic vehicles back in the 1970s. Paying expert attention to detail, the traditional model-makers have breathed life into old moulds in order to create the DKW coupé in a

bicoloured design which makes for an attractive contrast. In addition, the Mercedes-Benz 220 S as the "Peterwagen" of the Hamburg police with its unusual "Auer" blue light along with the Opel Kadett B in a modest slate grey bring back memories of bygone eras in automotive history. Alongside these sits the Mercedes-Benz LP 1313 furniture removal truck in the impressive livery of furniture removal firm Anton Schlotmann with its cubic front which definitely makes it look like a youngtimer. The Joskin dumper represents another addition to the range of vehicles used for large-scale agriculture while N-gauge enthusiasts will delight at long-forgotten cars towing trailers carrying a rowing boat and motorboat.
