

NEW MODELS FOR AUGUST 2013 VW T3 "DOKA" IS BACK



The long-established model manufacturer WIKING remains faithful to its brand legacy with the addition of the popular VW T3 double cab! The interesting thing is that WIKING was already planning a model of this "Bulli" during the time of its production, but implementation of the "Doka" was rejected and the blueprint ended up in the archives. Appropriate for the summer of classics, other new additions include the legendary Magirus Sirius as an attractive flatbed

truck, the Fiat 600 with an open sunroof and the Trabant 601 S as a fire service vehicle. Youngtimer enthusiasts can look forward to a MAN tank truck from the 1970s in the popular ARAL colours. There is also new high-tech agricultural equipment: the Kuhn RW 1800 baler features rotating attachments and a movable platform, on

which the bales of hay can be placed. The Jumbo Combiline series from Pöttinger provided the idea for an innovative agricultural machine: the 1:87 model of type 7210D is both an ensilage and forage trailer. The last of the new models is the fire brigade Unimog U 411 in scale 1:160.

acelifts make it possible to bring back popular WIKING classics of the 1960s: the new items include the Henschel truck & trailer with tarp, the VW T1 double cab in "Lufthansa" colours and the smart looking Samba bus, as well as its counterpart, the Ford FK 1000 Panorama bus, and the Glas Goggomobil with an open sunroof. The VW Porsche with its impressive contemporary racing design,

takes us back to the 1970s, while the Opel Ascona B recalls the young-timer flair of the 1980s with its black vinyl roof and the dominant black side trim. Two modern-day emergency vehicles are also included – the VW Passat B7 as a police car and the VW Caddy as a highway maintenance vehicle. And

finally, two WIKING models manufactured to scale: the MAN TGM with the Rosenbauer AT body reproduces many details in scale 1:43; and the Lanz tractor in scale 1:160 is a finely crafted miniature version of the original.
