The breathtaking contrasts in scale, which will start WIKING fans and lovers of agricultural machines raving enthusiastically: The Claas Lexion 760 with Conspeed corn picker makes an impressive double debut in 1:87 and 1:32. Both model giants once again illustrate how much fun the WIKING love for details can be – and in such different scales, to boot! The Fendt Katana 65, likewise with

corn header, perfectly supplements the range of agricultural machines. Also up-to-the-minute: the VW T5 GP as a police vehicle and the Still Hybrid RX 70-30H forklift. In addition, the August program contains classics and youngtimers each of which defined an era: they include the fabulous Ford T5 convertible, the legendary Citroën HY panel truck and the venerable Büssing 8000 tow truck in the brand colors of

the Braunschweig-based manufacturer. On top of this, two contemporary trucks new to the program are heading straight into the collector's hands: the round-hooded Magirus of "Müller's Mühle" packed full of sacks and the Opel Blitz fire service all-purpose vehicle. The Eicher Königstiger gets ready for working in the fields, while the THW-Unimog U 400 with grader blade and true-to-life yellow light, the All Terrain Vehicle and the Mazda MX5 enrich the street scene magnificently. The Magirus post office truck joins the program in 1:60 scale miniaturization.
