

NEW MODELS FOR FEBRUARY 2012 FASCINATING CLASSICS



S ince WWII, automotive history has been shaped by classic small vehicles. That is why two new models joining the range are the Goggomobil with folding roof along with the Fiat 600. WIKING consulted historic documents during the production of both these models which are not only true to the original vehicles but also display a wealth of intricate details. Alongside these are further new models of classic vehicles in the form of the 4-door Ford Escort with its striking dogbone-shaped radiator grille, the BMW 1600 GT Coupé and the Ford FK 1000 as a police vehicle. WIKING has also created a shining example of a youngtimer truck, the Büssing 16 which appears for the first time as a trailer truck. Meanwhile, the Audi Q7 towing a trailer and the Scania Topliner with facelift bring us right up to the present day again. Newcomers joining WIKING's larger models include the MAN TGM with updated Rosenbauer AT body in 1:43 along with the mighty Fendt 939 Vario with twin-tyre arrangement as an international diecast model in 1:32. ith the new construction machinery models for February, there is a striking contrast between scales: the HR 18 mini-digger appears in both 1:87 and N-gauge, making an attractive duo. In addition, WIKING has created an attractive mix of model vehicles ranging

from classics to youngtimers. These include the Samba van, the "Pretzel" Beetle and the Porsche 914 from VW as well as the Citroën Pallas and the Büssing forward drive bus with passengers. The Allgaier single-axle trailer



from the 1960s shows just how much times have changed in the world of agriculture as it is dwarfed by the Kaweco dump trailer that sits along side it. The traditional model-makers have created an addition to the highly popular series of "Milestones from WIKING's history" in the form of the limited edition set entitled "Fast & robust: the Hanomag service fleet". The large circular garage that is bound to evoke memories of the 1960s amongst avid collectors also makes a reappearance as part of the set.
