Classic models bring delight – and the new models joining the range which will be available in specialist shops in February are no different. Following a surprise discovery of historic moulds, the Krupp Titan joins the range for the first time with an open flatbed behind it. A splendid WIKING veteran has been created complete with crane boom assembly and the design in the livery of Paul Rosenkranz. The Unimog U 406 makes an appearance in the form of a new combination, pulling the bulk material trailer of "Kohlen

Wuttke", alongside another trailer with number "2" and "3". WIKING has created the Seat 600 as a new model along with the VW Beetle 1200 as a police patrol car which is enhanced by the added feature of a loudspeaker. These are joined by the VW Amarok with hard top in the livery of the German Rescue Association and the Mitsubishi Pajero as a THW control vehicle as well as the VW Passat B7 taxi, the Brantner single-axle trailer with high sides and the DHL swap body trailer pulled by the very latest MAN TGX tractor unit. The VW Tiguan joins the range as a convincing N-gauge model of an emergency doctor's vehicle while fans of the 1:32 scale will be delighted with the expanded movement and authenticity that WIKING has brought to its range of agricultural machinery.
