

The new high-end system is called WIKING CONTROL87, and for the first time allows model and remote control to communicate with each other. For the premiere, WIKING is presenting the Rosenbauer LF 10/6 firefighting vehicle on an MAN TGL chassis - top class high-tech operating beneath the body. The fire-fighting vehicle works with two servo-motors. Extremely sensitive manoeuvring in all directions as well as a small turn radius ensure enjoyment when driving the model vehicle. The fine digital proportional controller guarantees the true-to-scale steering movement. Headlamps, tail lights, indicators and blue lights can be switched via the remote control. The long-life lithium polymer micro storage battery powerfully and nimbly pushes forward the high-performance engine of the LF 10/6 with ideal traction into the wide world of the small model cars. And what is more, if required, a number of models can be controlled with just a single

remote control. In this way WIKING succeeds in creating a new dimension of car authenticity in the 1:87 scale.


