A wonderfully contrasting mix of models – WIKING has succeeded in bridging the gap between past and present. Of course, the Claas Xerion 5000 system tractor outshines the other new models with its rotating cabin – just like the original – and WIKING's proven filigree perfectionism. The street scene from the present in 1:87 is also made up of the VW Amarok as a winter maintenance vehicle along with the municipal Brantner single-axle tipping trailer and the multi-purpose fire service boat based on the

original Lehmar MZB 72. Then there is the BMW 1600 GT cabriolet to evoke memories of the final decline of the Glas era while the melon yellow VW Polo will arouse a real sense of the world of youngtimers. N-gauge enthusiasts also have something to be excited about in the form of the Opel Admiral which joins the range in scale with a high level of filigree detail

– and even more functionality: WIKING has equipped the Fliegl ASW 391 push-off trailer with its imposing overhead loading screw at the rear. This is another model that once again presents a fascinating level of detail within a piece of international agricultural machinery in 1:32. The mix of themes brings a successful end to a successful year for WIKING: the two up-to-date models of the VW Touareg and the VW T5 in the form of a Claas service vehicle are joined by the imposing hydraulic rescue platform on an Eonic chassis. The latter is a perfect replica of the Metz B32, especially in terms of the functionality of all the moving parts which match the original exactly. At the same time, the other classic vehicles evoke memories of all the automotive eras from the last century. For instance,

the Horch 850 makes a reappearance along with the legendary Mercedes-Benz 300 SL Roadster and the Austin Healey 3000 which represents the golden age of British automotive manufacturing. The US truck with contempor-

ary stake flatbed in the colours of John Deere takes us back to the early 1960s along with the Büssing 8000, the big classic truck with the long bonnet from the post-war era in Germany. The exclusive limited edition set entitled "Fire service support vehicles" is also being launched in December under the title "Technical emergency service vehicles from the 1980s".
